## New Metadata Type: Attachment

### Release date: 17 October 2014

A common request we've received has been to add functionality to allow the publication of metadata which cannot easily be captured in an existing metadata field, or as an image. Introducing the **Attachment!** We've created this new metadata type to allow the upload of other files, and allow their linking directly into the Movida UI.

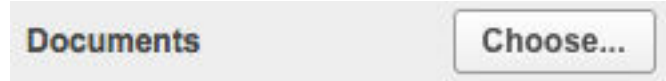

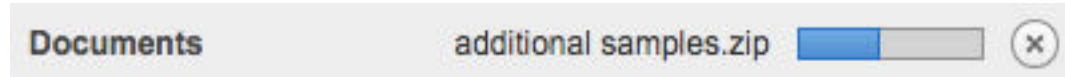

## File Attachments

When an attachment type has been added to the metadata configuration for your company, it will appear in the metadata list just like any other metadata field (in this case named 'Documents'):



Clicking **Choose...** will allow you to select a file from your computer or network. Once a file is selected it will upload to Amazon S3, and a progress bar will be shown in Movida:



Once the upload is complete, the attachment name will become a hyperlink for easy retrieval of the attachment. Deleting an attachment is simple as clicking the **x** beside the attachment name. Of course, the attachment type also allows for multiple attachments to be uploaded together!
