#### Release date: 26 April 2013

When problems occur downstream of Movida with the processing of metadata it has published it can be useful to know exactly *when* publication occurred and *who* initiated the publication.

Movida has been changed so that details (including the username, date, and time) of each publication are recorded in the Activity page (in a new section called "Metadata publications") and in the "Overview / History of this title" section of the Catalog.

## Activity

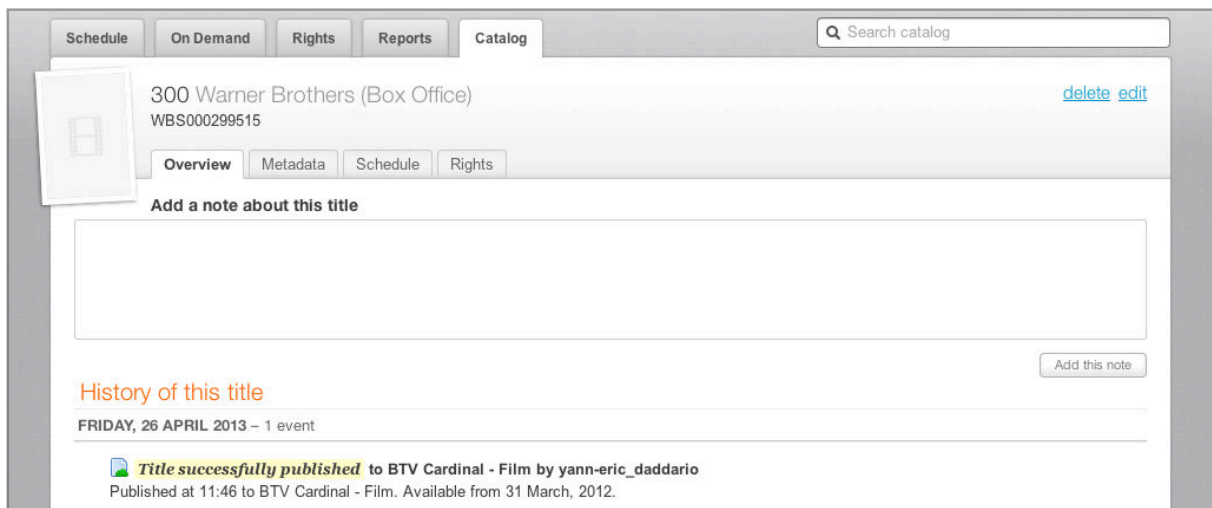
The **Activity** page in Movida provides an audit trail of changes made in the Catalog, Rights, and Schedule; a new "Metadata publications" section has been added:



For successful publications the metadata icon is green, and red for unsuccessful publications. You can click-through to the title in the Catalog.

## Catalog

The "History of this title" page for a title in the **Catalog** also shows the publication; for successful publications the metadata icon is green, and red for unsuccessful publications.



The availability window start date is also shown so that you know which **Schedule** entry the publication was for.
