

## Breadcrumb navigation

Every page you visit in the Catalog now clearly shows you where you are, and allows you backtrack easily. This example shows an Episode in a Series:

Notice the breadcrumb trail at the top of the Catalog page that in this examples tells you you're on the Schedule page for Episode 1 of Borgen season 3.

You'll also see that the size of the poster image has been increased and that the licensor, tags, and parent details (Series and/or Collection) are now prominently displayed in the new summary section.

The name in the summary section also clearly indicates whether you're working on a Title Group (Collection), Series, Episode or Feature.
