Following the change introduced on 1 July that lets you easily duplicate an Asset, we've made some small changes to the Assets page for Titles in Movida.



Catalog

When you view the Assets page for a Title you'll notice that the **Duplicate** option has been renamed to **Copy** and that there's a new **Edit** option.

When you click the **Copy** option for an Asset an exact copy is created, except for the Asset Name which is unique and based on rules defined for your company in Movidia. The list of Assets can now be sorted by Name, the direction of the triangle shows the order (ascending or descending).

If you want to edit an Asset you now use the **Edit** option instead of clicking the name of the Asset.
