Improvements for Schedule Entry deletion

Schedule Entries in Movida can be thought of as the *products* that you provide to your customers, and are therefore valuable to your business. To help prevent mishaps we've added safeguards that clearly indicate what will happen if you choose to delete Schedule Entries.

This note describes what has changed in full, and as usual you can contact **support** or your technical account manager for further clarification.



Stop in the name of the law, citizen!

The first thing you'll notice is that the **Delete** button has been separated from the *bulk actions* you probably perform on a regular basis.

When you've selected some Schedule Entries and click **Delete** you are warned about what will happen, and are asked to proceed:





Please note that you must *click* the red **Delete** button, you cannot simply press return on your keyboard. Also, as usual you cannot delete *Catch-up* Schedule Entries.

If you choose to proceed, another dialog box is shown where you have to provide secondary confirmation that you want to delete the selected Schedule Entries.

Again, you must *click* the red button. If you go ahead, the relevant Schedule Entries are deleted and you'll see a green *flash* message in the Schedule page confirming the deletion.
