Limited access to Schedules

As our customers grow and distribute content to more and more locations, managing these schedules across the world, it can get harder for Movida users to make sure they are always working on the right thing.

We've introduced the concept of Teams to Movida - users can be added and removed from Teams, and these teams can have their access limited to only a subset of your available schedules within Movida.

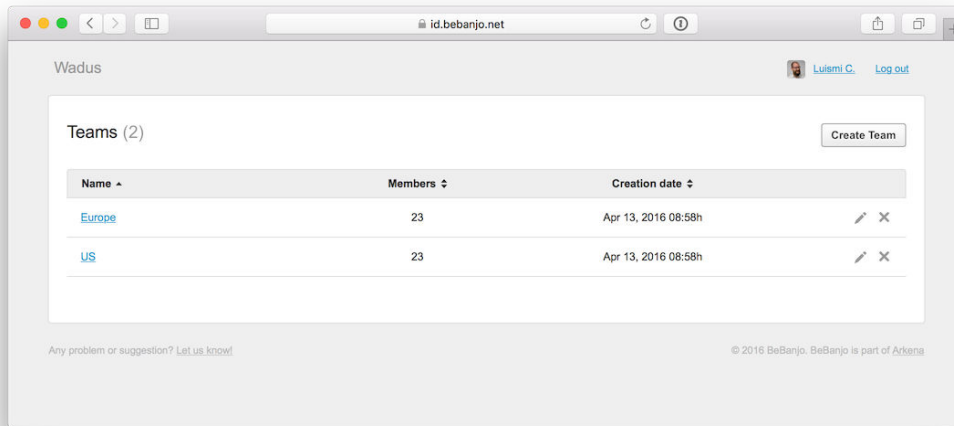

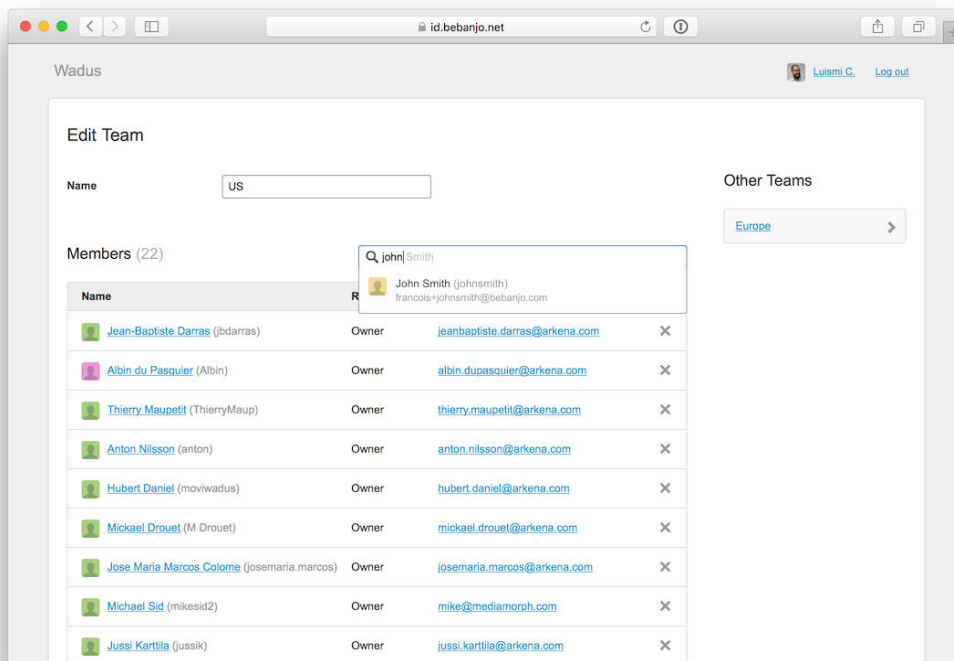

BeBanjo ID now allows Owners to manage Teams within their Company:



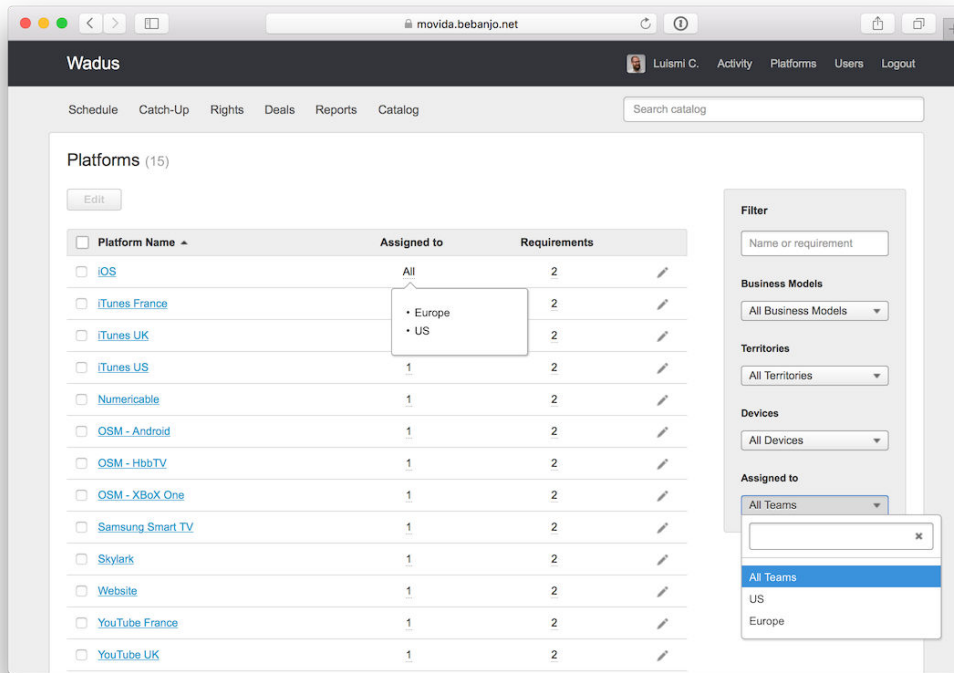
Teams can be updated by Owners to add or remove members:



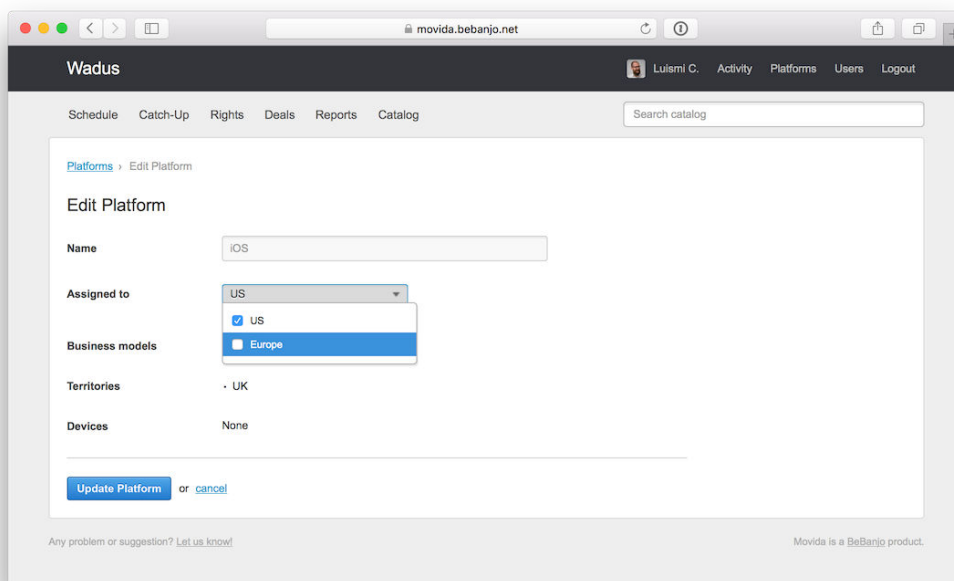
Granting Teams access to Schedules

Inside Movida, Teams grant access to the schedule of a limited set of platforms. Users will only have access to the schedules granted to the teams they are part of.

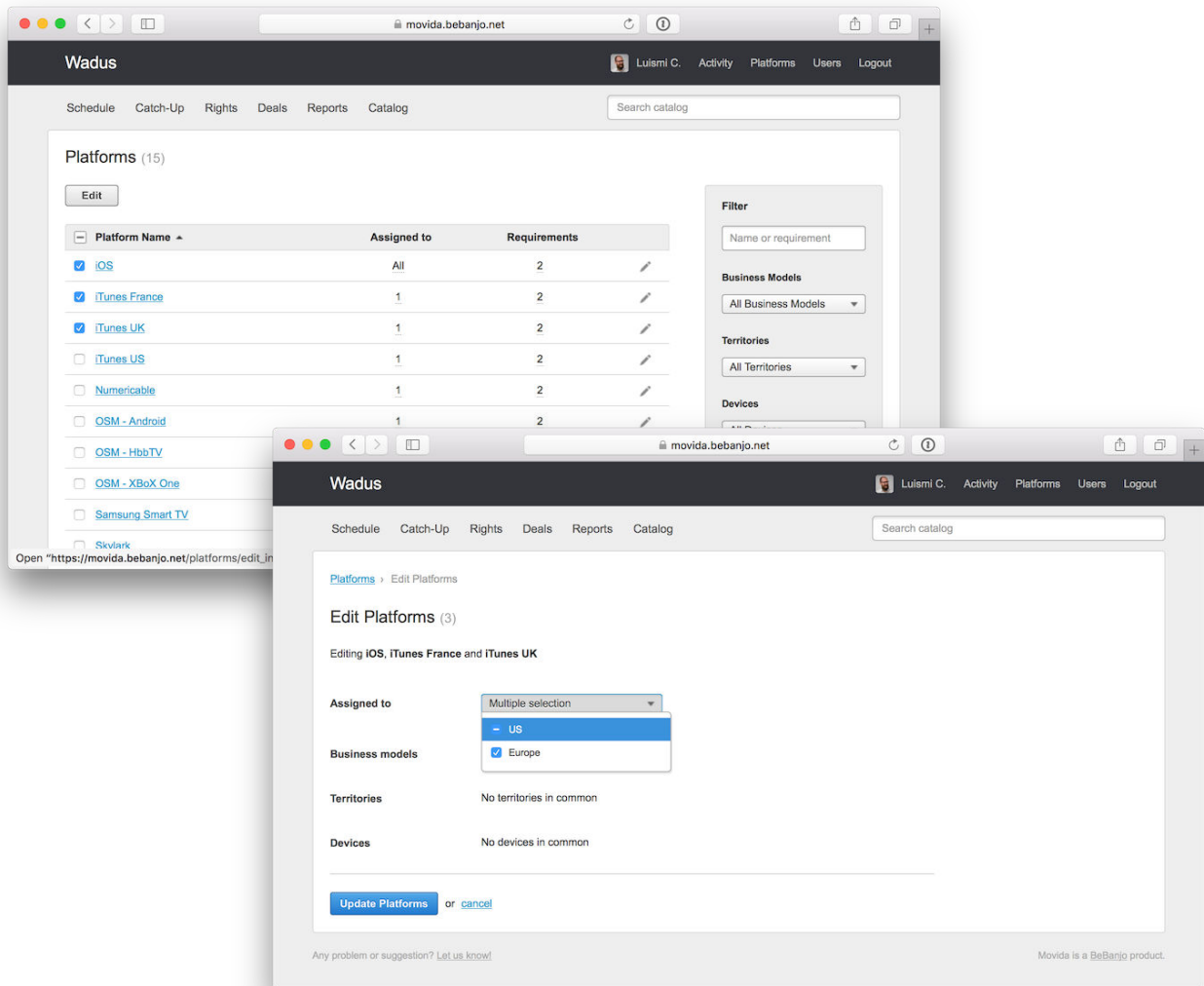
Within the platforms page of Movida, owners can manage which teams have access to each schedule:



Clicking on the pencil button in the above page will give the user access to the edit form of a Platform where team access to that Platform's schedule can be managed:



For additional convenience, you can also update team access to multiple platforms in bulk:



For users, Movida looks exactly like it always did! However, they will only be able to see and manage archive and catch-up scheduling for any Platforms the teams they have been added to have access to. Teams outside this list will be hidden from them.

Note that owners will always have access to all the Platforms in the account regardless of any teams they might be part of.
